PATHWAY 1: SCHOOL DESIGN TEAMS

Facilitated by **ed.Xtraordinary** for the Nevada Future of Learning Network

A School Team (3-7 members) engages in learning cycles guided by in-person and virtual coaching. School Teams focus on pursuing school-specific innovation projects aligned to the Portrait of a Nevada Learner. The Teams will also identify opportunities to implement personalized, competency-based learning practices.

This is a good fit if you:

- Want to collaborate with other educators to address learning relationships, experiences, and environments aligned to the Portrait
- Want to practice integrating competencies that align with my project
- Are open to working with a community of educators, students, families, and education leaders to reveal policy and practice gaps

PATHWAY 2: COMPETENCY CHAMPIONS

Facilitated by **KnowledgeWorks** for the Nevada Future of Learning Network

Competency Champions (at least 2 educators from the same campus) engage with in-person and virtual professional learning and coaching, together and with other Champions statewide. Competency Champions focus on implementing competencies on their campus, refining competencies based on their own experience and field feedback, and supporting the creation of a toolkit of best practices for educators across Nevada to scale the implementation of personalized, competency-based learning.

This is a good fit if you:

- Are committed to implementing competency-based learning in your classroom
- Want direct support on thinking through your instructional approach
- Are excited to take feedback on the competencies and apply it to a refining process
- Want to be a competency-pro and help other educators do the same

Do I have to apply to be in both pathways?

You can, but you don't have to! Competency Champions will interact with School Design Teams to share what they are learning and seek feedback on competency-implementation to support refining these competencies.

What resources are available to support me?

Stipends, mini-grants for supplies, coaching, and travel support are among the resources provided to participants. Follow up on the exact links above for specifics with each pathway inside the respective application.

What's the commitment?

Participants in both pathways will be invited to three in-person convenings between September '23 and June '24. The remaining learning and coaching cycles will occur virtually. A detailed calendar will be available soon.

What is a Portrait of a Learner?

A community-wide vision statement of the attributes a learner must possess to succeed both academically and in life, now and into a rapidly evolving future.

What if I'm Part of an Existing School Pilot Team?

Existing Portrait Pilot Teams are invited to continue implementing work; with an opportunity to collaborate with up to 30 teams this coming school year.
